

Study Abroad Options

Exchange

- take courses at a partner university
- pay Leiden tuition fees
- eligible for grants
- find an overview of partners on the world map on the website
- > can be university-wide or faculty!

Internship/ Research Project

- not limited to partner universities
- no application deadlines
- you arrange the internship yourself
- eligible for grants

Free mover

- take courses at <u>any</u> university, without an agreement and/or selection
- you pay Leiden tuition fees <u>and</u> host university tuition fees
- not all universities accept free movers!

Summer/Winter School

- short term program
- not limited to partner universities
- not always for ECTS

University-wide versus Faculty Exchange

University-wide Exchange

- deadline is December 1st (2024)
- outside the EU, with partners in North and South America, Asia, Africa and Oceania
- Open to all Leiden University students
- Selection done by International Relations Office
- Selection based on a draw
- Highly competitive

Faculty Exchange

- deadline is February 1st (2025)
- mostly inside the EU, with a few non-EU partners such as China, Singapore and Japan
- Open to *only* Faculty of Science students
- Selection done by Science International Office
- Selection based on letter, GPA and course choice
- Less competitive

What is an Exchange?

Going on exchange means taking courses at a partner university as part of your study programme. As an exchange student, you have the advantage that you will not have to pay the tuition fees of the partner university abroad and can use the credits for your curriculum in Leiden. This exchange is facilitated by an 'exchange agreement' between Leiden University and the partner university. If this contract is open to all Leiden University students, it's called a University-wide exchange. If this contract is open to students at the Faculty of Science, it's called a faculty exchange. The different exchange programmes have a:

- 1. different offer of partner universities
- 2. different deadline and application procedure
- 3. different contact person at Leiden University
- 4. different scope of agreement (i.e. in which area of study can students

What Should I Keep in Mind?

When considering which partner university is right for you, it is good to take note of the following points:

1. Intended for students from: the world map indicates the study programme for which the agreement is intended. For example, an agreement in the field of Biology is intended for Biology students. It is possible for a non-Biology student to choose this agreement, as long as they take courses in this field at the partner university. However, Biology students have priority to go on exchange via this agreement over students from other study programmes. 




World Map

- Our Exchange agreement
- Leiden's Board of Examiners

Application Process



Exchange Requirements

- You are a registered Leiden University student before and during the exchange
- Your study programme agrees with your plans to study abroad
 - **Who?** For your application: your study advisor. Later officially via Board of Examiners.
 - When? BSc 3rd year minor or MSc 2nd year (MSc Mathematics MSc 1st year 2nd term).

 Discuss other options with your study advisor!
- You have passed all first-year courses (*propedeuse*)
- You are a nominal student
 - No study delay
- You (preferably) have a GPA of 7.0 or higher

Faculty only: If you do not meet these requirements, you can still apply. However, your application will be discussed with the study advisor and not all partner universities will be an option.

- Your top 5-10 partner universities
 - The program is highly competitive, so more selected partners are required!
- Motivation letter for your top 3 choices
 - Submit *one* letter
 - Template can be found <u>online</u>
- LST students: your TU Delft Transcript of Records
 - We cannot see your grades in uSis!

- Your top 3 partner universities
 - Fewer or more choices allowed; we will contact you if we cannot place you in your top 3.




Application - uSis

How:

- 1. Log in to uSis and select the 'Study Abroad' tile
- 2. Select 'Study at a partner university via an exchange programme'
- 3. Click on 'Create' to start your application







→ Academic year: Select the academic year of your exchange (25-26), not the current academic year!

▶Duration: Select 1 semester.

Exchange Programme: Submit one application per exchange programme - it is not possible to select both uniwide and faculty partners in one application. Please have only <u>one</u> active application at a time (wait for uni-wide results to apply for faculty exchange)!

Application - Deadlines

Faculty Exchange

23:59 on 1 December 2024

Late applications will not be considered

23:59 on 1 February 2025

Late applications will only be considered when the selection is completed and places are left

Do not wait until the last minute – apply on time!

Registration - uSis

Registration, not application!

Please look at the <u>website</u> for more detailed information about finding a research project abroad. After being invited by a university or company, you can register in uSis.

How:

- 1. Log in to Usis and select the 'Study Abroad' tile
- 2. Select 'Register another type of study-related activity abroad'.
- 3. Enter the requested data, upload any required documents then click on submit.
- 4. If you have the necessary faculty approval and your destination is safe, the university will approve your registration. You may then depart for your activity abroad. Remember to check the travel advice before departure in case the safety situation changes.
- 5. As soon as possible, enter your contact details abroad in the Study Abroad portal in the 'During your stay' section. Remember to keep your contact details updated whilst abroad so we can reach you in case of emergency!

What are the costs involved in studying abroad and how can you finance your stay? Avoid unexpected expenses by researching financial matters thoroughly in advance.


