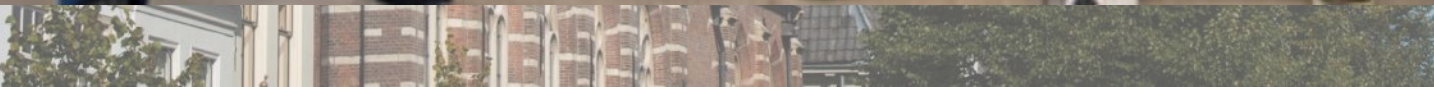

Diploma's, Titles, Registrations

- BSC + MSC Basispsycholoog.
- Clinical ambitions with a foreign bachelor: not impossible.
- Clinical ambitions in NL, without clinical internship: hard because of ZPM.
- LOGO-statement (important for ZPM) and BAPD, typically Dutch registrations.
- NIP offers services and registrations for both clinical and non-clinical psychologists.
- Registration with NOBCO as a coach or trainer?



Prepare for the future:

- FSW career services, CV and cover letter, not just for after graduation, also for internships
- Networking , Alumni mentor network, LinkedIn
- Create job search profiles: experiment!
- Be your own boss, start your own company

Regardless: start networking!

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Disclaimer:

This is relevant for students that choose a clinical specialisation (any direction) and aim to practice healthcare psychology in the Netherlands!

Zorg-Prestatiemodel (ZPM)

Due to the introduction of the Zorg-Prestatiemodel, effective as per January 1st 2024, employers may require you to have a LOGO-statement in order to work as a “basis-psycholoog”, with clients who pay for their treatment through their healthcare insurance.



LOGO-statement & BAPD 1

- **A bachelor and (research)master with different institutions?**
→ **You may not meet with the education requirements!**
- **Both your Bachelor in Psychology and Master in Psychology from Leiden University?**
→ **No worries: You will be able to meet with the requirements!**
- **Non-clinical specialisations do not prepare for LOGO and BAPD!**
- **Doing a Research Master C&H or Developmental?**
→ **Include the required mandatory courses and additional clinical internship in your programme, and you may still be able to meet with the requirements.**

LOGO-statement & BAPD 2

- All clinical master specialisations in Leiden have a slightly different allocation of credits. This may be relevant if you did not take your Bachelor in Psychology with Leiden University.
- There are hardly any remedies for shortages if you do not have sufficient credits in all fields.
- You took your bachelor outside Leiden? Better save than sorry: consult with j.h.wiltjer@fsw.leidenuniv.nl

BAPD

- Acquiring a BAPD requires additional supervision on the required 3 diagnostics cases during your clinical internship.
- This additional supervision is only offered for School Psychology and Child and Adolescent Psychology.
- Other clinical specializations are referred to the OU, after finishing their master, for an individual trajectory.
- Please be aware that outside the field of School Psychology and Child and Adolescent Psychology, having a BAPD is not that common.
